We are aiming to reduce the amount of documents that need printing, so we will be asking the children to complete the work on a laptop and email it to their teacher. In the case of children in Keystage 1, the children may complete tasks on paper. These should be photographed and emailed to Ms Turner (s.turner@farthinghoe.school)

The children in keystage 2 will be loaned a Google Chromebook. If any child in year 1 or 2 does not have access to a computer/laptop, then they will be loaned an iPad from school.

The children have been taught how to use their email address and how to send messages and work to their teacher. If the children are in year 5 and 6 they have also been taught how to upload a google document.

In the eventuality that a member of staff is unwell then in the first instance (for three days) parents will be referred to the Oak Academy lessons. Following this period of time alternative arrangements will be organised using a teacher in school or if this is not possible a teacher from within our Multi Academy Trust will provide work and support.

Remote Learning Plan

EYFS

The children in this class will receive one live meeting a day (Zoom) from 8.45am - 9.15am. This may include both English, Maths and a story. A package of activities linked to the teaching will be put on the website. This may include games and role play. Each week the children will be listened to read online with a teaching assistant. Photos/scans of the completed activities will be sent to Ms Turner via email and they will be responded to in a timely manner.

Year 1

A weekly timetable will be put on the website with linked work (Class page on the website). This will be uploaded on the previous Friday. The tasks may need to be printed however this will be kept to a minimum. The live lessons for this year group will be delivered using Zoom. The links will be emailed to the parent's email address.

Maths - The children in this year group will have a live lesson at **9.30am – 10.00am**. They will work with Ms Turner using the Power Maths resources which will be brought home.

English - In English Ms Turner will deliver a live lesson for years 1 and 2 at **11.15am - 12.00pm**. This will include a story and a task. When completed this can be emailed to Ms Turner on a Friday and the work will be marked and returned.

In the afternoon the children will be set a task that does not include the use of a computer. This will be art, science, music and Geography/History. Generally this will be a family task that can be completed with siblings.

Year 2

A weekly timetable will be put on the website with linked work (Class page on the website). This will be uploaded on the previous Friday.
