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Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to let you know that our Puffins and Swifts classes (EYFS, Year 1 and Year 2) will be going on a school trip on Wednesday 18th March to the Stratford Butterfly Farm.

As part of their spring learning, the children, accompanied by Mrs Hodson and Mrs Thompson, will enjoy a wonderful day discovering hundreds of beautiful butterflies flying freely in an exotic environment filled with tropical plants, splashing waterfalls and fish-filled pools.

The children will travel by coach from Farthinghoe to Stratford, stopping in Priors Marston on the way, where they will be joined by the Year 1 and Year 2 class from The Priors School. Please be assured that our children will remain with Farthinghoe staff throughout the visit and will not be placed in combined groups.

The coach will leave Farthinghoe at 8.20am and we therefore ask your child arrives at school by 8.15am at the very latest. If you have an older sibling, you are welcome to drop them at school at this time too.

We kindly ask that children wear full school uniform (not PE kit) and bring a lightweight waterproof jacket. They will also need a packed lunch. If you have already ordered a school lunch for that day via Arbor, please ensure this is cancelled.

The children will return to Farthinghoe in time for the end of the school day.

The cost of the trip, including transport and entry to the farm, is £23.50 per child. In line with our 'Charging and Remissions' policy, this is a voluntary contribution; however, please note that the trip will only be able to go ahead if sufficient funds are received.

The trip is now available to view on Arbor. We kindly ask that you provide consent and make the voluntary contribution by Thursday 12th March.

Finally, we would like to extend our thanks to Mrs Bufton for organising the trip, liaising with our colleagues at The Priors School, and helping to arrange what promises to be a fun and memorable day for our younger children.
