Dear Parents/Carers

We are delighted to confirm that Year 3 and 4 will be participating in a full day Roman workshop at The Priors School (their Year 3/4 class will also participate) on Tuesday 10th February.

The children will travel from Farthinghoe to Priors Marston in a Warriner School minibus and will leave around 8.45am and will return in time for the end of the school day. We kindly ask that children bring in a small snack for morning break and a packed lunch.

Hosted by 'Portals to the Past' this workshop will enable Year 3 and 4 to delve further into their Roman Britain topic exploring the founding of Rome and learning about the development of the early Empire, including the invasion of Britain. There will be quizzes and an opportunity to handle objects, as well as learning about medicine, engineering, military, the end of Roman Britain and the discipline of archaeology. There may even be a chance to try on Roman armour!

The children are encouraged to immerse themselves by coming in costume or by bringing a prop! This can be anything from a Celtic tribe member to a Roman emperor or citizen. The cost of the workshop is £11.62 per child and this includes the transport to Priors Marston. Whilst this is a voluntary contribution we must make you aware that without sufficient funding, the event will have to be cancelled.
