Skip2Bfit Workshop - Thursday 24th September

As a reward for coming back to school with a good learning attitude and for working so hard during assessment week, we have arranged a Skip2Bfit workshop for the whole school on Thursday.

Children will be shown how to do a basic skip and watch a short demonstration showing them what can be achieved through practise.

The children will be taught in small groups (year groups) and music is used to motivate the children. We hope to hold the workshop outside, however we have booked the village hall, just in case.

Each child will receive a Skip2Bfit skipping rope, with an integrated counter, which they can keep. The length of the rope can be adjusted - so they whole family can use it!

Children should wear their PE kit for the duration of the school day - including EYFS.

Pick up and drop off

The Government and this School is absolutely committed to remaining open. We are aware (and parents have mentioned) that there are a lot of adults waiting and standing in a very small area outside school. With that in mind, we would like to alter our drop off and pick arrangements, as we feel this will reduce the number of adults waiting on the green triangle between pick up times.

Therefore, keystone 1 will continue to be dropped off at 8.50am - siblings of children in keystone 1 may come into school at this time to take part in quiet reading in their classroom. For the children without a younger sibling in keystone 1, they will continue to be dropped off at 9.00am.

In the afternoons, those children in keystone 2 with a younger sibling may leave class at 3.05pm whilst their peers complete quiet reading until their collection at 3.15pm.

For this to work, it is essential that parents arrive and leave in a timely manner to prevent the number of people gathering. There will not be an adult at the gate between 8.50am and 9.00am therefore it is imperative you arrive at the correct times.

These new timing arrangements will begin tomorrow (Tuesday 22nd September)
